INTRODUCTIONS & NORMS



Norms

Stay engaged. Stay with the topic Stay present in the conversation.

Speak your truth. Speak about your lived experience. Avoid the universal “you”, instead speak from “I” vs. “we”.

No fixing. No solutions. We often try to fix issues or provide solutions. Try to avoid this tendency.

Experience discomfort. Learn to be comfortable with discomfort.

Take risks. The more you are willing to risk, the more potential you have to learn.

Listen for understanding. Try and understand where another person is coming from as best you can.

Expect & accept non-closure. This is ongoing work. These are process conversations where greater awareness leads to future changes.
